Welcome to an international seminar on European Organic Research

Conclusions, Implementation and Future Collaborations

CORE Organic Research projects 2013-2018

18th of October 2016, Bucharest, Romania

During this interactive seminar, project leaders from EU countries will present and discuss the achievements from three research projects supported by CORE Organic II which ends in 2016, and eleven projects from the CORE Organic Plus call which started in early 2015 will present their intermediate results. Representatives of funding bodies and other stakeholders as well as research colleagues will have an overview of these projects and an opportunity to exchange on their outcomes. Such outcomes will also be confronted with current perspectives in organic and EU research agendas. Special attention will be given to lessons learned in terms of knowledge generation and dissemination. There will also be possibilities for networking, with future research collaborations in mind.

Participants [about 60] are funding bodies from the CORE Organic Plus consortia, project leaders and local/national interested stakeholders from Romania and other countries, especially neighbouring ones (Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary).

Participants will have leaflets presenting each project, and their expected results.
