Sessions 3.1 - 3.3: Valorisation Workshop: working groups ¹

The valorisation workshop will consist of small working groups similar to 'training units' on specific topics. Appropriate stakeholders representing different 'worlds' (government/policy, agriculture, economics, industry...), that we call ambassadors (since they are knowledge ambassadors) participate in the workshop and will work in small groups (around five people) with the researchers. The idea in the working groups is to create a debate on how to shape the available results/information with a perspective for valorisation in its different forms.

The Valorisation workshop will conclude with a joint discussion. Ambassadors and researchers will give feedback on common aspects, requirements and conclusions so far.
