1. AIM AND THEORY

 aim: to map the 'roads' — hyperlinks — between websites related to vaccine hesitancy to be able to identify the most central websites — those that are most central on the map
roads are needed to come from one place to another — hyperlinks are needed for web content to travel




2. DATA AND METHOD: THE ARCHIVED WEB

- >material extracted from the national Danish web archive Netarkivet, hosted by the Royal Danish Library
- > annual 'time slice' of the entire Danish web domain .dk, 2006-2015
- >all hyperlinks extracted from these data, app. 10 million hyperlinks per year
- > used as the basis for the hyperlink network analysis



2. DATA AND METHOD: HYPERLINK NETWORK ANALYSIS

- >network analysis well known method within the social sciences for decades
- >combined with web studies in the late 1990s because a hyperlink constitutes a materialised relation
- >recently also used for historical studies of the archived web



Importance in the network measured as centrality: > in-degree centrality > out-degree centrality > betweenness centrality



2. DATA AND METHOD: HYPERLINK NETWORK ANALYSIS


- > existing literature tends not to include <u>the network</u>, non-expert websites seen as isolates (e.g. Moran et al.: "What makes anti-vaccine websites persuasive? A content analysis of techniques used by antivaccine websites to engender anti-vaccine sentiment")
- > "let the network talk", include the web ecology in which non-expert websites are embedded



3. FIRST DIGS

Analytical steps:

- >identify website type:
 - <u>non-expert</u> websites ('nothing is what it looks like', conspiracy theories, UFOs, alternative medicine...)
 - <u>official expert</u> websites (the Danish Ministry of Health, etc.)
 - <u>semi-official expert</u> websites (patients associations, NGOs, etc.)
- > start list of 355 websites




Non-expert website: <u>tagryggen.dk</u>, right-wing, anti-establishment, conspiracy theory-like Christian website Non-expert websites: <u>mayday-info.dk</u>, provides critical information about health issues



3. FIRST DIGS

Analytical steps (continued): > extracting all in-/outgoing links from these websites in the total link graph of the Danish web > mapping the hyperlink network, using Gephi



Immediately visible results:

> official and semi-official websites are the most central
> fact checking website present, faktalink.dk
> non-expert websites are also predominant, in particular alternative medicine, but also tagryggen.dk
> antivax: mayday-info.dk, degree 4, sund-skepsis, degree 0 (top-40 >5)
> social media absent

The hyperlink network 2006 — degree centrality, 692 nodes, 451 edges



The hyperlink network 2006 — filtering for the three types of websites

Immediately visible results:

- >uriasposten.net, non-expert most central, like tagryggen.dk
- >other non-expert websites still predominant, alternative medicine and conspiracy theory tagryggen.dk + oplysning.org (new)
- when filtered: expert websites tend to cluster, nonexperts do not, no links between the two types
 antivax: mayday-info.dk, degree 3, sund-skepsis,
 - degree 0 (top-40 >10)
- > mainstream media present (e.g. dr.dk, q.dk)
- >social media present (Facebook, YouTube, Twitter)

Immediately visible results: > same clustering structure > right-wing conspiracy theory-like websites and websites about alternative medicin are central > antivax: not very predominant > mainstream media appear in 2015 > social media appear in 2015

Development in the hyperlink network 2006 to 2015

- > work more in detail with the hyperlink network analysis
- > combine with discourse analysis of central websites
