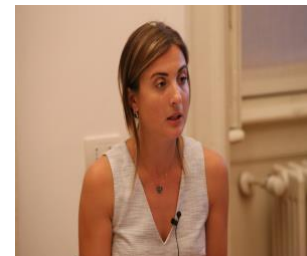

**About Speaker:** Dr. Federica Lucivero is a Senior Researcher in Ethics and Data at the Wellcome Centre for Ethics and Humanities and the Department of Population Health. In her research, she explores ethical and social aspects of the increasing introduction of IT (online portals, wearable sensors, mobile apps) in care pathways, individual health practices, and biomedical research. She has been writing on the environmental sustainability of Big Data initiatives and received a British Academy/Leverhulme grant to conduct an exploratory study on “digital sustainability”. She is a co-Investigator on an ESRC collaborative project PARIS-DE (Design Principles and Responsible Innovation for a Sustainable Digital Economy). In her role as Director of the Big Data Ethics Forum, she liaises with data scientists at the Big Data Institute and organises and chairs seminars bringing together an interdisciplinary community.
