
National target: 'Restore at least 15% of degraded ecosystems by 2025'



## Wetland Restoration Plan

- The first Wetland Restoration Plan for Norway was published in 2016
- The plan was a joint effort by the Norwegian Environment Agency and the Norwegian Agriculture Agency
- Updated in 2020 (as we learned a lot during the first years of restoring)





## Bog restoration

- 105 bogs restored (2015-2021)
- Mostly inside protected areas (easier than outside, due to our Biodiversity Act)
- Some other wetland types also restored



## Political support

- Bog restoration is beneficial for both climate and biodiversity
- Political will to restore bogs
- In 2016 wetland restoration got its own budget item in the State Budget
- Approx. NOK 20 mill/year
- Not yet any incentives linked to restoring bogs on private land



## How the work is organized

- The Norwegian Environment Agency is the national project leader and allocates funds
- The county governor and the nature inspectorate (SNO) are responsible for the restoration projects regionally
- Framework agreement for contractors
