Sandbjerg Gods is probably most convenient to reach by car, please consider coordinating carpooling with your team:

From Billund Airport: ~1 hour 45 minutes by car

From Copenhagen: ~3 hours by car

From Hamburg, Germany: ~2 hours by car

If you would like to use public transportation, you can take a train from Copenhagen or Hamburg to Sønderborg Station, then take a short taxi ride of approximately 6 km to the venue. Shuttle bus: A shuttle bus has been arranged for participants

Accommodation



Rooms at Sandbjerg Gods have been reserved for PIG-PARADIGM project participants during the Annual Meeting, with all participants accommodated in individual rooms. Please note: The 2026 Annual Meeting program concludes in the early afternoon of June 4. Participants are encouraged to plan their onward travel accordingly and cover any accommodation not included. **Accommodation for the night of June 4 will not be covered, except for participants traveling from the United States.** For international participants arriving via Copenhagen Airport, hotel accommodation near the airport can be arranged for the nights of June 1–2 and June 4–5, with the cost of the night of June 4–5 covered only for U.S. participants. If hotel accommodation is required, this can be selected during the registration process.
