Plant2Food is a 5-year platform funded by the Novo Nordisk Foundation from 2023-2027. Our vision is to accelerate the transition to a more sustainable, plant-based food system, which is healthier for both the planet and its population by building a leading hub for plant-based food research and innovation.
